The City of College Station-Brazos Valley Solid Waste Management Agency maintains an internship program of a part-time intern at all times. Interns work 20 hours per week during the regular school term and the summer.

This position is currently budgeted at \$8.00 per hour. Interns work on a variety of projects, including but not limited to: TCEQ, Master Composter training program, Household Hazardous Waste Collection program, Planet Earth Celebration, Texas Recycles Day program, environmental monitoring and reporting, and other programs relating to recycling and solid waste management.

Graduate students, seniors, and juniors in civil or environmental engineering, environmental science, or related fields will be considered. Knowledge of spreadsheet and word processing applications is required. This position also requires technical writing skills. Interns occasionally work in non-office environments, and may be required to work on a weekend as needed. Possessing a valid Texas driver's license and the ability to pass a pre-employment drug screen is a requirement.
