The Dr Pepper Museum and Free Enterprise Institute is seeking qualified individuals for its Summer 2009 Internship program. Internships are for 10 weeks at 40 hours per week. Start of the internship is flexible. Internships will be in the Programs area of the Interpretation Department. The intern will work with his/her assigned staff member on a special project based on the needs of the museum and the intern's requirements.
