The hiring authority used to fill the positions requires that the applicants currently be enrolled at least half-time in an undergraduate or graduate level college program and that they be returning to school in the fall. The job title to reference during the application process is:

Knowledge and Skills preferred for this position:

- a. **Knowledge of the natural and/or cultural history of the coastal area.**
- b. **Ability to do research for educational programs.**
- c. **Communication skills, especially oral presentation skills.**
- d. **Ability to speak Spanish and English (not required, but is a plus).**
- e. **Ability to perform basic first aid. (If you are not currently certified, we will provide the training you need).**
- f. **Ability to interact positively with park visitors providing them with accurate and appropriate information.**

Important Details:

Length of employment: mid-May through mid-August. (Time of employment is negotiable)

Pay is \$12.73 per hour for 40 hours per week. About 40% of your time will be outdoors. No housing is available in the park. You may be working weekends and holidays with Sunday and holiday pay.

If you are selected for the position it will be contingent upon passing a background check.
