Job Description
(Summer 2009)

- Administration: Assist staff with summer camp registration, run reports, manage accounts, and assist customers with on-line registration process. Student will be exposed to agencies budget process, promotions and marketing plan, staff training, scheduling and evaluations. Student will engage the public providing quality customer service daily. Student will assist with other administrative duties as needed, attend staff meetings, and Board of Director's meeting.
- Programming: Student will assist Summer Day Camp Directors with daily operations of camp. Duties would include leading groups, teaching specialty camps, organizing special events and activities. Student will be exposed to the ACA accreditation process assisting staff will standards and compliance. Student will also work with staff on other programs outside summer camp such as athletics, aquatics, concessions, and special events.
- Facilities/Operations: Students will assist Athletic Director with field maintenance as it relates to sporting events. Swimming pool operations, transportation issues and equipment maintenance will be introduced.
