

**River Guides/Environmental Educators
Lower Rio Grande Valley
One-Year Renewable Positions**

Fanatical about river sports? Want to have an impact on society? Los Caminos del Rio, a 501-c-3 founded to preserve and promote the environmental and cultural heritage of the Lower Rio Grande has two openings for

Americorps VISTA volunteers to train Valley youth as river guides, develop outdoor education curricula for local schools and ultimately change the way the world views our nation's third longest river.

VISTA volunteers receive a \$200/week stipend and full health coverage for a one year commitment, and receive an end of year \$3000 educational bonus (or \$1000 in cash).

The Lower Rio Grande Valley is one of the oldest settled areas of the country, home to its own cuisine and music and is a candidate to become a National Heritage Area. Paddling is possible year-round, the beach is 60 miles away, and some of Mexico's best whitewater is just an overnight bus ride away.

Anyone interested in exploring the opportunity to relocate here for a one-year (renewable) contract with VISTA should apply directly through Americorps VISTA. Enrollment for the next 4-day obligatory training (all expense paid to get there) in Denver must be completed by May.
